CITY OF DUBLIN TO HOST 6^{TH} ANNUAL SPLATTER FESTIVAL

Saturday, September 16, Noon to 8:00 PM, at Emerald Glen Park

DUBLIN, Calif., August 28, 2017- The City of Dublin celebrates water, wine, art and music at its 6th Annual *Splatter* event on Saturday, September 16, at Emerald Glen Park, 4201 Central Parkway. The event begins at noon and will conclude with an evening dance party concert by The Peelers beginning at 6:30 p.m. Admission to the festival is free; however, there is a charge for children's carnival rides and games. *Splatter* is known for its fun, family-friendly art activities; unusual art installations; artist demonstrations; live music and dance performances; cooking demonstrations; and a craft and culinary marketplace.

Festival-goers will be able to enjoy community group performances of music and entertainment in the new Emerald Glen Park Amphitheater, as well as pop music at the Main Stage located on the sports field on the Gleason Road side of the park, and singer-songwriter performances near the fountain along Central Parkway. The day's entertainment concludes with a dance party featuring The Peelers, a high-energy dance cover "mash-up" band.

Guests can learn new cooking tips from Master Chefs at the Culinary Stage. Beverage booths will sell local wines and beers, and traditional fair food vendors and trucks from Food Truck Mafia will sell a wide variety of foods, including deep-fried calamari, grilled garlic oysters and salmon, lumpia, deep-friend asparagus, roasted corn on the cob, Hawaiian-style grilled chicken, and authentic Mexican tacos and burritos.
