FUNERAL SERVICES SET FOR THE LATE VICE MAYOR DON BIDDLE

DUBLIN, Calif., February 24, 2018 – The family of the late Vice Mayor Don Biddle has set the funeral services for March 1 at John Knox Presbyterian Church in Dublin. Vice Mayor Biddle died Wednesday, February 21 while fighting a brave, but brief battle with pancreatic cancer.
