DUBLIN CITY COUNCIL TO APPOINT OPEN CITY COUNCIL SEAT; ONE WEEK APPLICATION PERIOD BEGINS TODAY – MARCH 21 THROUGH MARCH 28 AT 5:00 PM

Interested Candidates Must Complete Online Application or Hand Deliver Signed Application to Dublin City Clerk by the 5:00 p.m. Deadline on March 28; No Postmarks Accepted

DUBLIN, Calif., March 21, 2018 – At the March 20 meeting of the Dublin City Council, the City Council decided to conduct an appointment process for the vacant city council seat resulting from the recent passing of Vice Mayor Don Biddle. The City Council will consider this appointment at a special City Council meeting on April 2.

The City will begin accepting applications for the City Council vacancy beginning today, Wednesday, March 21, 2018, through Wednesday, March 28, until 5:00 p.m. All applications must be either submitted online or hand delivered and received by the City Clerk by this deadline; no postmarks will be accepted. Applications can be found on the City's website, www.dublin.ca.gov/councilvacancy, or in person by visiting the City Clerk's Office at Dublin City Hall, 100 Civic Plaza.

To select the candidate, the Dublin City Council will hold a special City Council meeting on Monday, April 2, at 6:00 p.m., in the City Council Chamber. If the City Council is able to reach a decision that evening, the selected candidate would begin serving the term of the vacated seat immediately. This City Council seat expires December 2018.
