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CITY OF DUBLIN TO CELEBRATE “NATIONAL BIKE MONTH” WITH A HOST OF ACTIVITIES

DUBLIN, Calif., May 2, 2018 – The month of May is “National Bike Month,” when communities encourage people to give biking a try. In Dublin and throughout the Tri-Valley, many events are planned to support biking:

- **Bike to Work Challenge:** Throughout the month of May, residents are encouraged to get out of their vehicles and bicycle to work. Residents can register to track their miles biked at www.LoveToRide.net.
- **Family Cycling Workshop, May 5:** The City of Dublin and Bike East Bay have organized a family cycling workshop to help students learn how to ride safely to and from school. The workshop will include fun games, safety drills, and a neighborhood ride. The workshop will be held at Kolb Elementary School, 3150 Palermo Way, and is open to all families with children in grades 2-6. Participants should register at BikeEastBay.org/FCW.
- **24th Annual Bike to Work Day, Thursday, May 10:** Thousands of commuters throughout the Bay Area are expected to participate in this annual event. In the Tri-Valley, the cities will host several events to promote bicycle safety and bicycling as a healthy way to travel. Energizer stations will be set up at the two Dublin BART stations during the morning commute (6:30-9:00 a.m. at the East Dublin/Pleasanton station; 7:00-9:00 a.m. at the West Dublin station), where participants can get free refreshments, giveaways, and bike tune-ups. Bike Dublin CA has also organized a post-work “Happy Hour,” 4:30-7:00 p.m. at Whole Foods in Dublin, 5200 Dublin Blvd.
- **Bike to School Day:** Students are encouraged to ride their bikes to school. Participants will learn bicycle safety tips and earn free giveaways. Parents and students of Dublin Unified School District should check with their school administration to confirm date of their event, as days vary throughout the District.
- **Community Bike Ride, Saturday, May 19:** Residents can join in on a two-hour local bike ride through Dublin and Pleasanton. Participants should meet at Mike’s Bikes of Pleasanton, 6754 Bernal Avenue, Pleasanton, at 9:30 a.m. The bike ride will begin at 10:00 a.m.

- **Bike to Market, Thursday, May 24:** Those who ride a bike to the Dublin Farmers' Market, 4:00-8:00 p.m., at Emerald Glen Park, 4201 Central Parkway, will receive five dollars in "carrot cash" to spend at the Market.

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
