

The City of Dublin is looking to strengthen the identity of its downtown through potential improvements to its streetscape, providing a better pedestrian experience. The City invites you to share your own ideas on Downtown Dublin's streetscape, and hear about possible improvements to create a more vibrant and dynamic downtown through a unified streetscape and identity program.

A Community Workshop will be held on **Wednesday, December 13, 2017**, at 6:00 p.m., in the Regional Meeting Room at Dublin City Hall (100 Civic Plaza). This meeting will provide an opportunity for the City to gain an understanding of your ideas, history, and experiences with the existing downtown streetscape.

You can also provide your feedback [online](#) and sign-up to receive notifications about further opportunities to provide input on potential improvements to Downtown Dublin. The input received will help the City to develop a Downtown Streetscape Master Plan to assist in the implementation of the City's existing Downtown Dublin Specific Plan (DDSP).

Potential improvements downtown, such as improved walkability, signage, furniture, and public art would be implemented through future public and private capital improvement projects.

Under Construction

Phase 1a of the **Kaiser Dublin Medical Center** project, a new 220,000-square foot medical office building, is currently under construction along Dublin Boulevard between Tassajara Road and the Fallon Gateway Shopping Center. The three-story building, which will include an urgent care clinic, medical office space, and a radiation/oncology center, is anticipated to open in 2019.

The site plan for the 58-acre site, which will be developed over the next two decades, includes 250,000-square feet of commercial uses and additional medical services buildings to create a 950,000-square foot medical campus serving Kaiser patients in the Tri-Valley area.
