




Dublin Restaurant Guide Winter 2018 Edition

Changes Approved for Dublin Place Shopping Center

In January, the City's Planning Commission approved plans by Johnson Lyman Architects to demolish the former Coco's Restaurant building at 7505 Dublin Boulevard and construct a new 9,383 square foot multi-tenant commercial building located within the Dublin Place Shopping Center.

The development will include two new outdoor dining patios, landscaping and parking. Tenants have not been identified for the buildings; however, it is anticipated to be four tenant spaces with a mix of retail and restaurant uses.
