Carl Zeiss Meditec Expansion in Dublin

The City Council recently approved the development of the Zeiss Innovation Center project, a campus office and research facility to be built in two phases on a vacant 11.36 acres site at the corner of Arnold Road and Dublin Boulevard. The project will triple the Zeiss workforce in Dublin. Phase one is expected to break ground this year and includes construction of a 3-story research & development building.
