Get Help with ADA Compliance

In order to help business and property owners meet the American Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements and ensure their facilities are accessible to individuals with disabilities, you can hire a State-Certified Access Specialist (CASp) to



tested on their knowledge of state and federal accessibility standards.

A CASp professional can inspect your business or property and:

- determine the accessibility standards to apply based on the facility;
- provide an action plan for the necessary changes; and
- offer legal benefits that may reduce financial liability in a lawsuit.

Having your business or property reviewed by a CASp shows that you care about ensuring equal access for all customers, and also demonstrates your intent to follow the law.
