Creating A Downtown Dublin: The Preferred Vision

After years of hearing from the community about the need to create a Downtown, the City Council initiated a process in early 2019 to establish a vision and location for a new town square and main street experience located in the City's original central business district - commonly referred to as the Downtown Dublin Specific Plan.

For the last several months, the City has been investing its resources and the City Council has been meeting in public work sessions with City staff and its consultant team to review the options for the town square and how to create a vibrant Downtown main street experience.

Over the summer, the City solicited community feedback on three town square options, with an overwhelming majority favoring "Concept A," the town square along an extended, future main street (Golden Gate Drive). This location is part of the Dublin Place shopping center, which includes anchor retailers Target, Hobby Lobby and Burlington.

In September, the City held a second community meeting to hear feedback on the proposed Preferred Vision, which includes a new and extensive street grid network with a walkable, pedestrian-friendly "main street" experience and a mixture of supportive land uses such as retail, office, hotel and housing around the town square. The City Council has not yet taken action to adopt the Preferred Vision.
