

**PROCLAMATION OF EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY
BY DIRECTOR OF EMERGENCY SERVICES**

WHEREAS, Chapter 2.44.060(A) of the Dublin Municipal Code, adopted on January 14, 1985, empowers the Director of Emergency Services to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a Local Emergency when said City is affected or likely to be affected by a public calamity and the City Council is not in session; and

WHEREAS, as the Director of Emergency Services of the City of Dublin, I hereby find that conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property have arisen with said City caused by an outbreak and community spread of COVID-19 in Alameda County; and,

WHEREAS, On March 16, 2020 the Alameda County Health Officer issued an Order directing all individuals living in the county to shelter at their place of residence, subject to certain exceptions, from 12:00AM on March 17, 2020 through 11:59PM on April 7, 2020; and,

WHEREAS, that the aforesaid conditions of extreme peril warrant and necessitate the proclamation the existence of a Local Emergency; and


WHEREAS, that the City Council of the City of Dublin is not in session and cannot immediately be called into session.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED that a LOCAL EMERGENCY now exists throughout said City; and,


BE IT FURTHER PROCLAIMED that this proclamation shall be in effect for a period of seven days, by which time it must be ratified by the City Council, pursuant to Dublin Municipal Code Section 2.44.060 (A)(1); and.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED THAT all City officers and employees take all steps requested by the City Manager to prevent the spread of COVID-19 and to prevent or alleviate illness or death due to the virus; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED THAT all City officers and employees take all steps requested by the City Manager to qualify the City for reimbursement from the Federal Emergency Management Agency and for other state and federal relief as may be available to reimburse the City for the expenses it incurs from this emergency.
