Special Notice to Dublin Businesses

Economic Injury Disaster Loans Available to Impacted Alameda County Small Businesses

U.S. Small Business Administration's Disaster Assistance Loans

On March 16, 2020, the [Small Business Administration \(SBA\)](#) approved an Economic Injury Disaster Loan assistance declaration for California, which makes loans available to small businesses and private, non-profit organizations in designated areas of a state or territory to help alleviate economic injury caused by the Coronavirus (COVID-19).

The declaration offers low-interest federal disaster loans for working capital to small businesses in Alameda County (and elsewhere) suffering substantial economic injury as a result of COVID-19. These low interest loans may be used to pay fixed debts, payroll, accounts payable and other bills that can't be paid because of the disaster's impact.



The Shelter In Place Order went into effect on 12:01 a. m. on Tuesday, March 17, 2020, and will continue to be in effect until 11:59 p.m. on Tuesday, April 7, 2020, or until it is extended, rescinded, superseded, or amended by the Alameda County Health Officer.

The Alameda County Public Health Department has provided an [FAQ](#) regarding the current Order directing individuals to shelter at home except to provide or receive or engage in essential activities.
