



Dreams of Longing After Nothing, Bryan Tedrick, 2004

Located at Dolan Park, “Dreams of Longing After Nothing” is a kinetic sculpture powered by Dublin’s ever-present afternoon winds. Its 14-foot-long steel-and-bronze arm stands 12-feet in the air, rotating 360 degrees and tilting 25 degrees from the center axis. Artist Bryan Tedrick is an Oakland native whose public art is in municipal collection throughout Northern California and Reno, Nevada. He has also created a number of temporary sculptures installed at Burning Man and other events. This piece was a gift from the Dublin Fine Arts Foundation.
