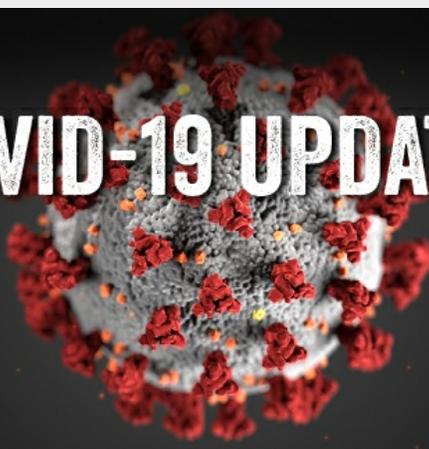

Alameda County Sheriff Issues Countywide Emergency Curfew Order

Alameda County Sheriff Gregory Ahern has issued a countywide Emergency Curfew Order, beginning tonight, June 1st, in order to preserve public order and safety throughout the County. The curfew hours are from 8:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. the following day. The Order is in place until 5:00 a.m. on Friday, June 5, 2020.

Per the Order, everyone must remain in their residence for the night unless traveling to their home or workplace or are in search of medical attention. Public safety personnel are not subject to this Order.

Last night's looting throughout Alameda County resulted in a tremendous amount of damage to businesses in a number of East Bay cities. On Sunday evening, Dublin Police Services did a heroic job of protecting access to the community as well as to many businesses using a significant increase in law enforcement protection. As we enter into another evening with the threat of looting, the City would encourage you to **secure your space as you see appropriate** tonight and take the following precautions:

- Don't leave things outside that could be used as projectiles (signs, chairs, tables, trash bins). Bring them inside or secure them.
