

## Special Notice to Dublin Businesses

July 15, 2020

### **Outdoor Dining Allowed to Continue in Alameda County While Worship Services Must Move Outdoors**

Today, July 15, 2020, the California Department of Public Health approved Alameda County's variance attestation, which now allows for the continuation of outdoor dining throughout the County.

However, the State of California has also added Alameda County to a COVID-19 Monitoring List, which means that worship services must occur outdoors with social distancing and safety precautions in place. Indoor malls must also close for at least three weeks, which will not affect Dublin retailers.

The Health Order states that while outdoor dining may continue, face coverings are required at ALL times and may only be removed during the physical act of eating or drinking.

Employers can help stop the spread of COVID-19 and demonstrate their commitment to keeping their staff, customers, and communities safe by supporting employees' decisions to stay home, and ensuring that they follow the state and local guidelines in implementing [Site-Specific Protection Plans](#).
