## City Offers New Daytime Recreation Program for Children

As the new school year gets underway, a new program to provide support for **working parents** of children in 1st to 5th grades is being offered by the City of Dublin. Registration is now open for L.I.V.E 'n' Rec (Learning in a Virtual Environment). The program features two, three-week sessions, beginning Monday, August 17 and will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on weekdays.

The program will provide supervision for students to complete online school learning modules as well as recreation such as cooperative games, activities, sports, fitness activities, creative play and arts and crafts. The cost of a three-week session is \$300 for Dublin residents and \$360 for non-residents.

## Updated Federal List of Effective Disinfectant Products

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends cleaning and disinfecting frequently touched surfaces as one way to protect against a coronavirus infection.



The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) maintains a list of effective disinfectants, called [List N: Disinfectants for Use Against SARS-CoV-2](#). In July, EPA added 13 disinfectant products to the list of cleaners proven effective for use against SARS-CoV-2 on hard surfaces.

The [Guidance for Cleaning and Disinfecting Public Spaces, Workplaces, Businesses, Schools and Homes](#) (created by the EPA and CDC), can help you make a plan for which surfaces you'll need to disinfect and which require routine cleaning whether to ensure the cleanliness and safety of your business and home.
