Located at Jordan Ranch Park, Progression reflects a beautiful natural environment and shows some of the historical significance of Dublin and its surrounding area. One of the main images in the design you will find is an emphasis on nature. The deer, bird and rabbit will represent wildlife and oak trees. Flower and water images will represent the rich nature of Dublin and its neighboring regions past and present.

The Transcontinental Railroad connected the East Coast with the West Coast in the early 1860's and is a significant historical event which affected many of the developments in the surrounding area. It is represented by the stylized images of horses and trains "The Iron Horse".

The types of tiles to be used in the art work will include handmade and carved relief terra-cotta tiles. The imported porcelain tiles and glass tiles represent "water" and commercial tiles are to be glazed by local school children with their interpretation of Dublin. The artwork serves as a gentle reminder for the public/visitor and local school children to appreciate the environment they live in.
