

The Restaurant Revitalization Fund (RRF) program website is

The Small Business Administration (SBA) will announce the application launch date shortly. Once the application portal opens, you will be able to apply through the SBA or through an SBA-recognized Point of Sale Restaurant Partner such as:

- Clover
- NCR Corp.
- Square
- Toast

The SBA will host a [webinar](#) on **Wednesday, April 28, 2021 at 11:30 a.m.** covering program details and how to submit an application. The webinar is limited to the first 20,000 registrants, however, it will be recorded and later posted on SBA's [YouTube channel](#).

Round Six of the California Relief Grant Program Opens April 28

Reminder: On **Wednesday, April 28, 2021**, Round Six of the [California Relief Grant](#) opens. The program offers grants up to \$25,000 for small businesses impacted by the pandemic.



If you need assistance with your application, the Small Business Majority, a national small business advocacy organization, is offering one-on-one application assistance over Zoom. [Sign up](#) for a 15- or 30-minute time slot on April 29, April 30, or May 3, 2021.

Shuttered Venue Operators Grant

The Shuttered Venue Operators Grant (SVOG) program provides emergency assistance for eligible venues. Administered by the Small Business Administration, the program received federal funding to provide \$16 billion in grants to shuttered venues. The application portal re-opened on April 26, 2021 and is currently accepting applications.



Eligible applicants may qualify for grants equal to 45% of their gross earned revenue, with the maximum amount available for a single grant award of \$10 million. A portion of the funding is reserved for eligible applications with up to 50 full-time employees.

Eligible entities include:

- Live venue operators or promoters
- Theatrical producers
- Live performing arts organization operators
- Museum operators
- Motion picture theater operators (including owners)
- Talent representatives
