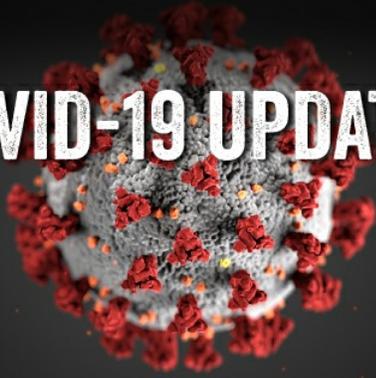

Restaurant Revitalization Fund Informational Webinar in Multiple Languages

The Small Business Administration (SBA) is hosting a webinar today (**Thursday, April 29, 2021 from 2:30 p.m. - 3:30 p.m.**) in nearly 20 languages about the Restaurant Revitalization Fund (RRF).

The webinar will cover what you need to prepare for the RRF application process. When you join the webinar, you will be asked to select from the list of languages to listen to the event in your preferred language: Spanish, Mandarin, Korean, Japanese, Vietnamese, Thai, Khmer, Hindi, Gujarati, Punjabi, Tagalog, Swahili, Samali, French, Haitian-Creole, Arabic, Portuguese, Russian, Chuukese, Marshallese, and English. Registration is required to attend, and a link to the webinar will be sent after registration.

Tips for Applying to the Restaurant Revitalization Fund



Registration for the Small Business Administration's Restaurant Revitalization Fund (RRF) application portal will begin on **Friday, April 30, 2021**. Applications can be submitted beginning **Monday, May 3, 2021 at 9:00 a.m.** (noon ET). The RRF application portal is online at restaurants.sba.gov.

The RRF provides funding to help restaurants and other eligible businesses keep their doors open. This program will provide restaurants with funding equal to their pandemic-related revenue loss up to \$10 million per business and no more than \$5 million per physical location. You are not required to repay the funding if funds are used for eligible uses no later than March 11, 2023.

Registration Begins Friday, April 30, 2021

You are encouraged to register on the site prior to Monday, May 3, 2021. To register, you will need an email address, a US cellphone that accepts SMS text messages, and to create a username and password.

- Even if you previously created an account on SBA.gov (i.e., to apply for an Economic Injury Disaster Loan), you will need to register and create a new account to apply for RRF as the application portals are unique to each program. The person who creates the account and submits the application online must be authorized to sign the application on behalf of the business.
- The application portal requires two-factor verification including a SMS text message sent to a cell phone. You may not be able to verify your phone number if it is a landline, a VOIP phone number, or if your cellphone provider is not based in the USA.
- You can also apply through SBA-recognized Point of Sale (POS) vendors including Square, Toast, Clover, and NCR Corporation (aka Aloha). If you are working with Square or Toast,

you do not need to register beforehand on the application portal.

- You are encouraged to use a modern internet browser such as Chrome, Edge, Safari, etc. (not Internet Explorer) to access the application portal.

Prepare Now to Apply Using the Sample Application Form

The application portal will open to all applicants on Monday, May 3, 2021. Although the SBA will process “priority group” applications in the first three weeks, all business owners are encouraged to apply as soon as the program opens as funding is limited for this nationwide program.

You are encouraged to prepare your application in advance using the sample application form including gathering all the required documents. Then, when the application portal opens on Monday, you can simply copy your responses into the application and upload the required documents (such as your business tax returns or other gross receipts documentation).
