

Coronavirus Employer Portal for Information About Safe & Compliant Operations



The California Labor Workforce and Development Agency's COVID-19 Employer Portal is a tool designed for California employers to find state and local COVID-19 guidance for their businesses. The portal can be used to generate custom road maps of information so that businesses can operate safer, protect employees, and prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the workplace.

The COVID-19 Employer Portal has been updated with changes to state guidance that went into effect June 15, 2021, as well as Cal/OSHA's revised Emergency Temporary Standards that went into effect June 17, 2021.

Additional Funding Rounds for California Small Business COVID-19 Relief Grant Program

As a reminder, the application window for **Round 9** of the California Small Business COVID-19 Relief Grant Program is September 9 through September 30, 2021. **Round 9** is for new applicants and waitlisted applicants from certain previous rounds. Applicants not selected to move forward in the review process in Rounds 1, 2, 3, 5, 6,

or 7 do not need to re-apply and will be automatically moved into **Round 9**. New applicants will need to apply.

COVID-19 Relief Options

The U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) still has programs in place with funding to aid in recovery from COVID-19 aftereffects.

- COVID-19 **Economic Injury Disaster Loan (EIDL)** program provides funding to small businesses and non-profit organizations currently experiencing a temporary loss of revenue related to COVID-19.
- The **Shuttered Venue Operators Grant** program provides emergency assistance for eligible venues. The SBA will begin sending invitations for supplemental awards for those who received an initial grant and have illustrated specific losses.
- SBA offers debt relief to existing SBA loan borrowers whose businesses have been impacted by COVID-19.
