



Metamorphosis, Joey Rose, 2021

Located at Butterfly Knoll Park, Metamorphosis is dedicated to native Bay Area species. Large abstract shapes stretch across the walls leading up the stairs. The left wall is inspired by butterfly wings. Inside each shape is a design relating to the patterns and colors of a specific native butterfly. The right wall is inspired by the butterfly's corresponding caterpillars. If you walk in a straight line from a caterpillar to a butterfly on the other side, the species will match. The paintings wrap around the walls at the top of the stairs to be seen from street level. The stairs leading up to the street are colorfully painted, enforcing the connection between the walls and creating an eye-catching gradient.
