



CALL FOR DESIGNS

City of Dublin 40th Anniversary T-Shirt Design Contest

ISSUE DATE: March 11, 2022

DEADLINE: June 30, 2022, 4:00 p.m. PST

While the history of Dublin can be traced back hundreds of years, Dublin remained an unincorporated area of Alameda County until 1982. To celebrate Dublin's Ruby Anniversary, the City of Dublin will mark the occasion through a variety of events and activities throughout the year.

As part of the celebration, the City of Dublin is partnering with the Dublin Arts Collective and inviting local artists/creatives of all ages and levels to design a commemorative 40th Anniversary t-shirt. The community is invited to participate in commemorating this special milestone of the City's incorporation.

The t-shirt design contest is an opportunity to show the community what Dublin, and its 40 years of City Hood, means to you. Designs should reflect Dublin's diversity, culture, and heritage.

The contest kicks off to coincide with the City of Dublin's signature event, the St. Patrick's Day Celebration, and will conclude with the selected t-shirt unveiled and available for sale at the City's Splatter Festival in September.

This design contest is open to anyone who resides or works in the City of Dublin.

DESIGN THEME & SPECIFICATIONS & RULES:

- One submission per person. A parent/guardian must acknowledge participation for persons under 18 years of age participating.
- The design must be submitted digitally via the City of Dublin website (www.dublin.ca.gov/tshirtcontest). Designs must be of quality that transfers to textiles for t-shirt production purposes.
- Designs must be suitable for all ages and in keeping with community values.
- Designs should align with the theme as stated above and with the City's Values, which are part of the adopted Mission and Vision statements. Values include safety, inclusivity, diversity, equality, and history. To view the City's full Mission and Vision statements please visit www.dublin.ca.gov/72/Mission-Vision.

- Participation in the contest requires the contestant/legal guardian to give the City of Dublin, CA permission to use the design without compensation on the contest website as well as on other City of Dublin webpages for promotional and/or publicity purposes, including, but not limited to: newsletters, web pages, community events, City-owned broadcast, cablecast and print outlets, and general media circulation. I/We further grant permission for the names of the designer to be made public in conjunction with the use of the design. The City of Dublin will always include the creators name when using a design for any purpose.
- Provide a brief statement and title (100 words or less) about your proposed design. This could include your source of inspiration, the significance of the design(s) or a comment on the style or technique you have proposed. Each proposed design must have its own statement.
- Acknowledgement: Designs may include a small signature or name block in the lower left or right corner of the artwork that is clearly legible and does not interfere with the aesthetics of the design.

RULES

- This is a juried contest with a panel reviewing and judging submittals.
- A grand prize winner will be selected and receive a \$100 gift card to a local business. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners will also be selected and each receiving a \$50 gift card to a local business.
- City of Dublin reserves the right to choose the winner(s) and the right to refuse any submissions that don't follow the design theme and specifications.
- All designs must be submitted digitally. Designs must translate well to a digital medium and be of high enough quality allowing for transfer to textiles.

DEADLINE AND INCURRED COSTS:

All proposals must be received by **June 30, 2022, 4:00 p.m.** It is the responsibility of the applicant to verify the receipt of the electronic proposal by the scheduled deadline.

The City of Dublin shall not be liable for any costs incurred by responding to this request for a design proposal.
