



Crossroads, Steven Whyte, 2022

Located at Don Biddle Park, this artwork is constructed as a plaza, dissected by two roads, echoing Dublin's history as the intersection of stagecoach routes during western exploration and expansion. Within the plaza, a Veterans Memorial that celebrates all men and women who have served, currently serve, and will serve, especially those members from Camp Parks and the Dublin Community.

Each figure, standing at 150% of life size, represents a military service and historical era that is significant to Dublin and Camp Parks. A Navy Seabee, Marine, Airman, and Army Soldier, all of whom were present at Camp Parks between 1942 and today.

This Veterans Memorial celebrates the values that our community and US Armed Forces hold dear; Loyalty, commitment, duty, respect, selfless sacrifice, honor, integrity, and personal courage.
