The City of Dublin provides training and informational materials to ensure that City staff and residents are prepared to respond to natural and man-made disasters. Your preparation will inform and empower you to meet your own, as well as your family's, needs during what is normally an extremely chaotic period. Every member of the family should have an Emergency Preparedness kit for your home, car, and office to provide food, water, tools, and medical supplies for a minimum of 3-5 days following an earthquake, fire, or other major community disaster. Existing Building Electrification

We Want Your Opinion

The City of Dublin is developing a Building Electrification Plan to achieve the goals of the City of Dublin's *Climate Action Plan 2030 and Beyond* and to help prepare the community for upcoming state and local building appliance rules. Building electrification refers to the process of transitioning the energy systems in a building from fossil-fuel-based sources (such as natural gas) to electricity-based systems. This shift typically involves replacing fossil-fuel based heating, cooling, cooking, and water heating systems

with electric systems. The goal of building electrification is to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and improve local air quality.

The City wants your input to help develop the Building Electrification Plan. Please complete a short survey to provide your input and to help us understand your opinions about building electrification, the obstacles you think you would have to overcome to switch to electric appliances, and the fossil-fuel systems you have considered replacing with electric alternatives. City Receives CalRecycle Grant for Pavement Projects

Grant Helps Fund City's Street Resurfacing Project



The California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) recently awarded the City of Dublin \$103,324 from CalRecycle's Rubberized Pavement Grant Program. The State program promotes markets for recycled content road surfacing products made from California's waste tires, reducing the number of tires that end up in landfills. Dublin was one of 23 grant recipients for the fiscal year 2024-25 program. The grant will help fund construction of Dublin's annual street resurfacing projects this summer.
