SUMMARY OF ACTIONS TAKEN BY DUBLIN CITY COUNCIL

At its meeting held on Tuesday, January 14, the Dublin City Council took a number of actions. Below is a summary of actions taken:

- Presented the Lunar New Year proclamation.
- Recognized sponsors that contributed to City events, programs, and facilities in 2024.
- Recognized the Altamont Cruisers Car Club for their recent donation of \$3,500. The donation will be used for operating supplies

for the Dublin Police Services Crime Prevention Unit.

- Presented Certificates of Recognition to the winners of the annual "Deck the Homes" Holiday Home Decorating contest.
- Welcomed and introduced new City of Dublin Staff member Robert Magno, Assistant Civil Engineer with the Public Works Department.
- Approved the minutes of the December 17, 2024, Regular City Council Meeting.
- Accepted the Official List of Proclamations and approved the Annual Proclamation.
- Directed preparation of the Annual Engineer's Reports for the City's five Assessment Districts.
- Approved the Mayor's recommendation to appoint Deputy City Manager Hazel Wetherford as the Dublin representative on the Tri-Valley Community Television Board of Directors.
- Approved Trumark Homes' proposal for public art, designed by artist Eric Powell, at the future Francis Ranch development.
- Approved the agreement between the City of Dublin and County of Alameda regarding the enforcement of Conditions of Approval for the Alameda County Fire Training Center and waived the Site Development Review.
- Approved a Memorandum of Understanding with the California Department of Justice to accept a grant award from the Tobacco Grant Program for Dublin Police Services to support increased enforcement of state laws and City ordinances related to the illegal sales and marketing of tobacco, or other nicotine related products, including e-cigarettes, to minors for three fiscal years.
- Approved proposed changes to the City's Personnel System, specifically the Classification Plan and Salary Plan related to part-time job classifications.
- Approved a General Plan Amendment to update the Economic Development Element.
- Approved a budget change and approved an agreement with Gray-Bowen-Scott for Project Management Services for the Dublin Boulevard Extension Project.
