BASIS INDEPENDENT SCHOOL

Building Permit Issued for Dublin Campus



A Building Permit has been issued that will enable structural upgrade work to begin on the Basis Independent School. This is the first of several permits that are necessary to complete the proposed tenant improvements, construct a new gym building, and make related site improvements. The school will be located within the former Corrie Center office building at 7650 Dublin Boulevard, and will serve up to 800 middle and high school students within the existing building. The school is anticipated to open in the fall of 2026.


PLANNING COMMISSION VACANCY
