Enrollment Opens February 3 for This 10-Week Community Program



Dublin residents and employees can soon gain firsthand insight into local law enforcement through the 2025 Dublin Police Services Citizen Academy. Registration opens on **February 3** at 10:00 a.m. The 10-week program runs each Wednesday from 5:00 to 8:00 p.m., beginning **March 26**, and culminates in a graduation ceremony on **May 28**. Participants must be at least 18 years old and either live or work in Dublin. The Citizens Academy offers a unique opportunity to learn about law enforcement operations, strengthen community-police relationships, and encourage public involvement in community policing efforts.

STAY PREPARED FOR HEAVY RAINS

Flood Watch Through February 2 for Alameda County, including Dublin



The National Weather Service has issued a Flood Watch through February 2 for Alameda County, including Dublin. Heavy rains may cause flooding – stay prepared and follow storm safety guidelines.

Storm Safety Tips:

- Avoid driving if possible; never drive through standing water.
- Keep your car fueled and phone charged.
- Check emergency supplies (food, water, flashlight, batteries, first aid kit).
- Clear debris from storm drains and secure outdoor items.
- Keep garbage cans and cars at least one foot from the curb.

Maintenance crews will be clearing storm drains and removing fallen trees. The sandbag station at the City of Dublin Corporation Yard located at 5709 Scarlett Court is open and free sandbags are available for Dublin residents and businesses, with a limit of 10 bags per household or business.

CITY OF DUBLIN OFFERS PASSPORT SERVICES

Book Early for Summer Travel



Passport services are offered Monday through Thursday between the hours of 8:15 a.m. and 1:15

p.m. The City books 31 days in advance, on a rolling schedule, through our online booking system, which can be found at

<https://dublin.ca.gov/2270/Passport-Services>. For

your convenience, the City also offers passport photos for \$20 per person. Current processing times are 4-6 weeks for routine processing and 2-3 weeks for expedited processing (additional fee required).

Adult renewals are required in person, if your passport is more than 15 years from its issuance date (over five years expired). If you currently have an adult passport which is expired, or will expire within the year, you can renew your passport online at [Travel.State.gov](https://travel.state.gov). If you have a minor that is over 16, they are eligible for an adult passport but require an in-person appointment.

For urgent travel to a foreign country within 14 calendar days or in need of a foreign visa within 28 calendar days, you can visit the US Department of State website at [Travel.State.gov](https://travel.state.gov).

Communications During World War II




Visit the Dublin Camp Parks Military History Center through January 2026 to see a new exhibit, *Communications During World War II*. Explore

soldiers' heartfelt wartime communications with a special focus on V-Mail (short for "Victory mail," a postal system put into place during the war to reduce the space needed to transport mail). View personal letters and photographs of soldiers stationed in the Philippines and France. The exhibit also includes stamps, postcards, books, notes, drawings, and sketches, offering a glimpse into how soldiers stayed connected with their loved ones during the war.

The history center is located in Building 275, just outside the Main Gate checkpoint at Parks Reserve Forces Training Area (Camp Parks).
