- 4. People's Choice** - Voted on by the public! This award goes to the tree that captures the hearts of visitors and receives the most community votes.

## GUIDELINES

1. Tree locations will be assigned and shared by November 28.
2. Tree locations cannot be changed once assigned.
3. Each participant will receive one strand of battery-operated string lights to use in decorating their tree.
4. All trees will be real and approximately 5 feet tall.
5. Trees will already be set up in place on November 29 with an assigned number tag.
6. There will be no access to electricity; please use solar or battery-operated lights only.
7. Participants may decorate their tree anytime between November 29 and December 3.
8. The trees will be located outdoors at 100 Civic Plaza, by the fountain. Please ensure all decorations are weather-resistant and securely attached.
9. Participants must bring any additional decorations or materials they wish to use.
10. No food items may be used as decorations (for safety and cleanliness).
11. On December 29, please plan to collect all decorations and your tree if you wish to keep it.
