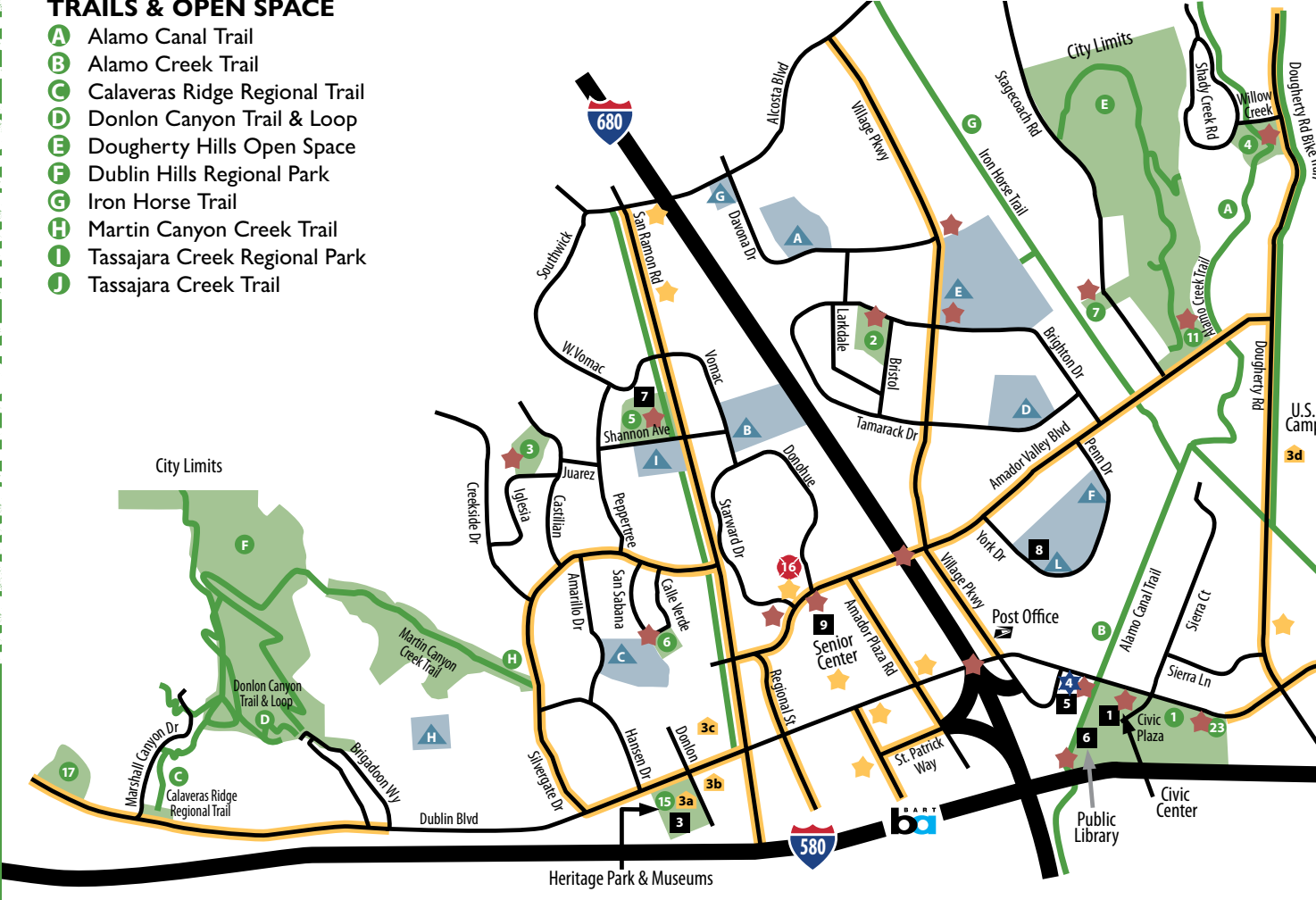

PUBLIC ART: IT'S LIKE HAVING A GALLERY, RIGHT IN YOUR OWN BACKYARD

One of the things that makes Dublin special is our wonderful collection of public art. The City owns and maintains more than 30 art pieces on City property for the public's enjoyment. Dublin's Public Art Ordinance calls for large private developers to set aside up to a half percentage of the project's construction value to install public art on their properties, or support the City's Public Art Fund.

Look for this public artwork the next time you are out and about in Dublin:

★ DIAMONDS IN THE WIND, IDE AND RUSSELL, 2021

Diamonds in the Wind is located at Sean Diamond Park, 4801 La Strada Drive. This is an 18-foot tall kinetic wind sculpture made of stainless steel. This colorful artwork features two diamond shapes nestled inside each other, that move with the wind in opposite directions. The tree-like form of the sculpture signifies growth and resilience as it stands rooted in the ground. The flower-like diamond shapes represent both seeds and blossoms, celebrating the accomplishments of this community.
